

## Instructions for finding, saving & citing photos on Flickr.com

- Go to <http://www.flickr.com/creativecommons/by-2.0/>  
(you might want to bookmark this page so you can get back to it easily)



Use this search box to find pictures so that they will all have the attribution license.

When you find a picture you like, click on the picture, then click on right above the picture to get a larger image to save



- Right click on the large image and choose 'save image as'
- Choose the correct folder to save to and name the picture using the name of the person who uploaded the picture (it will be at the top of the page)
- Click the back button to get back to the other photos
- If you are going to start a new search, make sure you are using the right search box (never use the search box at the very top of the webpage, that will take you out of the Creative Commons search)
- To cite Flickr pictures first open a PowerPoint document then
  - o Go to the folder where your pictures are and on the top menu click 'View' and then 'Thumbnails'
  - o Expand the folder to full screen and arrange pictures together in a box
  - o Click 'print screen' on your keyboard, go to your PPT and paste it there
  - o Click on 'Picture tools' at the top of the toolbar and then 'Crop'
  - o Crop the picture so that it is just your pictures and expand it to make it big enough to read the picture names
  - o Add writing that explains that these are photos from Flickr under the Creative Commons Attribution License
