Individual Board Member Authority Policy B15

All powers of the school board lie in its action as a group. A school board member has no legal powers or authority unless acting at a school board meeting or acting for the school board after it formally grants that board member power to act on its behalf.

An individual school board member, including the chairperson, shall have power only when the board, by vote, has delegated authority to him or her.

The board and its members will interact with the administration of the schools through the superintendent.
