

**Policy: Entrance Age**

It is our policy to ensure, to the best of our ability, academic success for each student enrolling in kindergarten or grade one. In pursuit of our goal we establish the following age requirements for admission in kindergarten and grade one:

Kindergarten -- Age 5 before September 1

Grade One -- Age 6 before September 1

~~A child, prior to the age of six who has not previously been enrolled in a state approved kindergarten or grade one will be placed in the grade determined to be appropriate by the school principal in accordance with the age definitions of this policy.~~

~~A child, prior to the age of six who has been previously enrolled in a state approved Kindergarten will be placed in the grade determined to be appropriate by the school principal in accordance with the age definitions of this policy.~~

Parents may request early enrollment for their children according to the procedure which is available by contacting the CCSU Office. Requests for an exemption require a screening process which is outlined within the procedure.

Decisions regarding entrance may be appealed to the Superintendent. The decision of the Superintendent shall be final.

Proof of Age: Proof of age (certificate of birth) must be furnished by the parent/guardian upon enrolling the pupil in school for the first time.
