

47 **Policy - Second Reading of Policy JGB: Bullying**

48 *Al Bombardier moved and Andre Roy seconded the motion to adopt policy JGB:*
49 *Bullying. There was no discussion. Motion passed 6-0.*

51 Policy JGB is now finalized.

53 **CCSU 2007-2009 Technology Plan**

54 Linda Keating presented the 2007-2009 CCSU Technology Plan that is mandated by the
55 state and federal governments to maintain eligibility for Title 2D funding and E-rate
56 funds.

57
58 The plan includes the creation and implementation of the Educational Technology
59 Integration Specialist position. Special focus is placed on portable LCD projectors for
60 presentations, as well as the use of “SMART Boards.” Highlights of the plan included
61 establishing “Standards of Practice” specific to CCSU to reflect best practices of the bi-
62 annual plan.

64 *Jeff Culkin moved and Al Bombardier seconded the motion to approve, reserving the*
65 *right to edit, the 2007-2009 CCSU Technology Plan. The motion passed 5-1 (G Miller*
66 *opposed).*

68 **Park Street Discussion**

69 Superintendent Mike Dewese described Parks Street as a “tri-board” issue as it is of
70 interest to all member boards.

71
72 Member districts mutually “serve notice” for any changes at Park Street and Discovery
73 Museum.

74
75 Superintendent Mike Dewese requested consensus regarding the formation of a
76 committee of board and administrator membership to study space utilization.

77
78 Superintendent Dewese and Martha Heath introduced and welcomed David Wells as the
79 new principal of Westford School.
