

PowerPoint	Photo Story
Allows for many elements to be arranged on a single slide - photos, text, video, etc.	Mainly for photographs, music and voiceover - limited ability to add text
Liner or non liner - many more uses than Photo Story	Only linear - basically a slide show creation program
No step-by-step procedure for creating a presentation	Step-by-step procedure the user follows - import pictures, edit pictures, add titles, add narration, add customized motion, add music, save - (Saving to add to e-mail is an option with the finished product)
Slower process - no express settings to make a slide show quickly	FAST - go with all the defaults and have a professional looking slide show in minutes  Can quickly do a brief narrative piece - music and customization are <u>not</u> a must.
Many options to add interest with custom animations to add emphasis, transitions, etc.	Along with choice of transitions between slides there is MOTION within photographs that you can easily change to help tell a story or leave on default settings  Customized motion allows you to emphasize areas of photos, such as maps or faces.
Music can be added	Music can be added AND it comes with its own library of music to choose from - no copyright issues.
Narration can be added	Narration can be added

### Photo Story Tips -

- Choose your music carefully. Pieces with dramatic shifts in volume can overpower your narration
- It's important to narrate in a slow, clear voice.
- Narration can become more important because you are NOT using much text. This is helpful to students who wouldn't grasp text on the screen.
- Be aware of "loudness" of various voices as you are recording narration.
