- His favorite color is orange



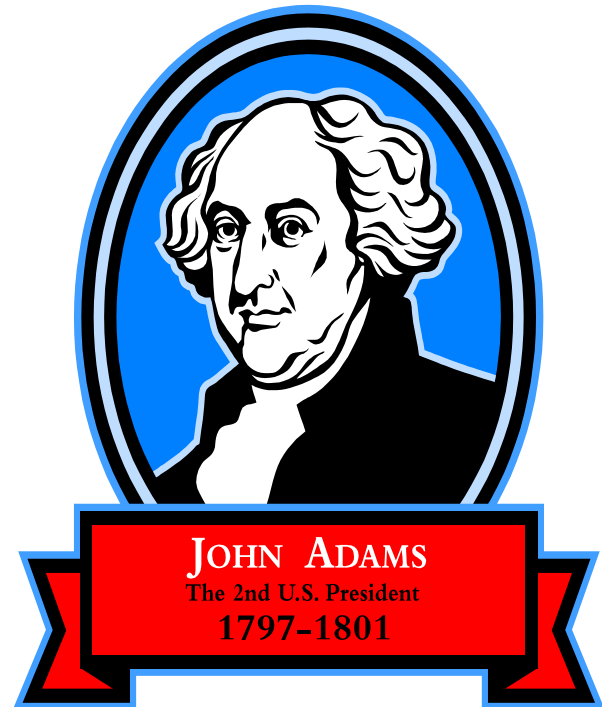
Adult life

Mississippi territory created[1798]

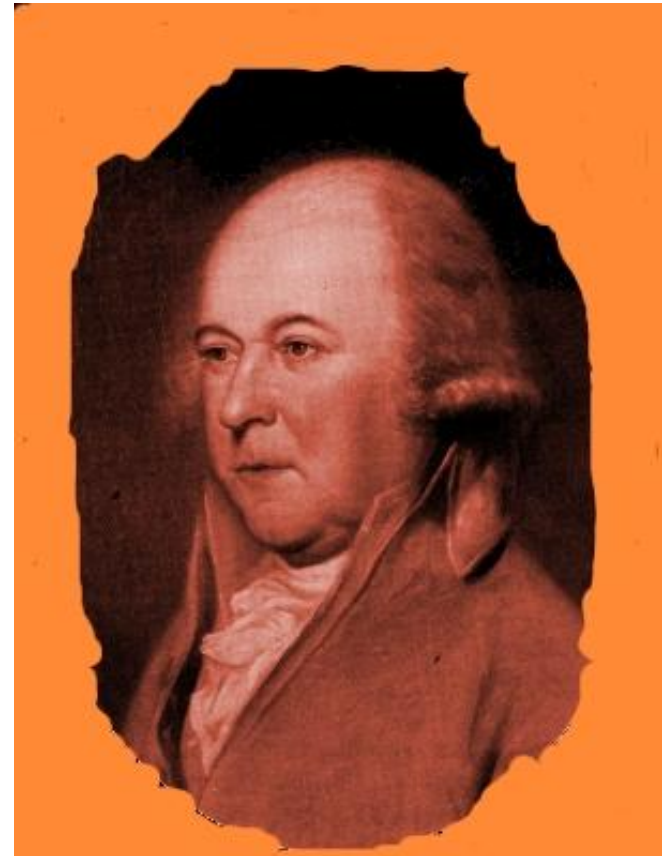
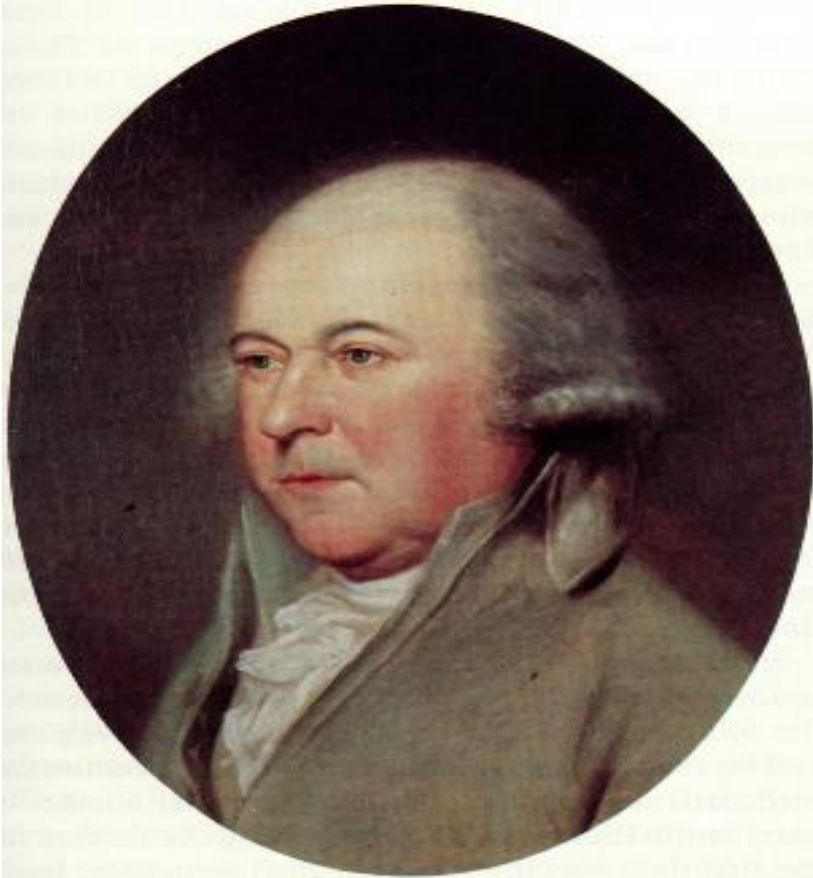
Capitol moved to Washington D.C[1800]
