

**Looking for easy ways to be involved in PTO efforts to support the programs and activities that make Fleming a great place to send our kids? Keep reading for some easy ways to contribute just by doing the things you are already doing!**



***Earn dollars for Fleming***

Did you know that if 100 Fleming families shop for groceries at Hannaford and each family earns just 3 Hannaford school dollars a week for each week of the program, Fleming will raise \$3,900? That's a lot of dough!

***Go online! Look for signs in-store***

Go to [hannaford.com/hhs](http://hannaford.com/hhs) for a list of the more than 700 participating products. While shopping, look for the tag indicating participating products: Purchase four in one shopping trip and earn a \$3 certificate at the register. Deposit the certificate in Fleming's spot in the specially marked collection tower near Customer Service. You can also put them in the PTO mailbox at Fleming.

***Stock up!***

All four items need to be purchased in one shopping trip to earn the \$3 for Fleming, so if you know you'll use the product anyway, just make sure you buy them in batches of four.

***Make sure you get your school dollars at the register***

Sometimes it takes a minute for the computers to register that you purchased four participating items and earned dollars for your school.

***Spread the news!***

Tell your family, friends, aunts, uncles, cousins, grandparents and neighbors about Hannaford Helps Schools. Many community members want to support Fleming but don't know about the program. If they live in another city or state, they can mail the dollars to you to deposit.

***Program dates:***

September 4 - December 3, 2011. All school dollars must be turned in by December 16th.



Did you know that when you shop at Price Chopper with your AdvantageEdge Card, you make it possible for Fleming to receive free educational equipment? All you need to do is enroll in the Tools for Schools program by logging on to <http://www2.pricechopper.com/toolsforschools> and registering your AdvantageEdge card. You'll need your 10 digit card number, which is on the back of your card and our school code, which is 15219. If you registered your AdvantageEdge card on or after August 1, 2010, you don't have to re-register this year but you might want to log on anyway to check your enrollment status and make sure that your purchases are being credited to Fleming.



Did you know that you can earn cash for Fleming by clipping Box Tops coupons from hundreds of participating products from manufacturers such as Nestle<sup>®</sup>, Betty Crocker<sup>®</sup>, Yoplait<sup>®</sup>, Kleenex<sup>®</sup> and Hefty<sup>®</sup>? Each Box Top coupon is worth 10¢ and that adds up fast! Drop your box tops in the PTO mailbox.
