At Fleming's Community time on **Wednesday, April 14<sup>th</sup>, at 2:30**, 5<sup>th</sup> grade students and Mrs. Madeira will present a look at American Greg Mortenson and his efforts to build schools for the poverty stricken children of Pakistan and Afghanistan. waiting for the teacher who came three days a week to work with them in a field. He promised to return and build them a school.
