SCHOOL TRAFFIC SAFETY



After school please follow the traffic flow directions from the staff members who are outside. Take the large traffic loop behind the school when picking up students, or the smaller pick up/drop-off loop in front of the school. When dropping off or picking up students in the front loop, please move up in line towards the front door and park next to the curb. The **left lane in the loop is an exit lane, NOT a passing or pick up lane.** Children should **NOT** be dropped off or picked up in the road or in the passing lane. Students are directed to **wait on the sidewalk** along the entire front of the school for pick up. We must keep traffic moving off the street in an orderly and safe manner.

In the morning, **please DO NOT drive through the large staff parking lot and drop students off there for the playground,** as many staff are arriving and parking prior to the start of the school day and parking in this lot. Thank you for helping to keep our students safe.

We ask that you please call the Fleming office attendance line if your child will not be attending school



on that day. The attendance line number 857-7004. Students are asked to bring a note when returning to school to explain the reason for their absence. Our health office is made aware of students who have been absent due to health reasons.
