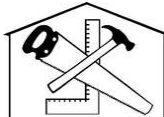
## BBQ CELEBRATION

## PLANNING ROOM DATA

During the month of May 28 students were referred to the school planning room to write 42 improvement plans in the school planning room. The data for the school year shows that 207 plans were written by Fleming students this year. The grade/gender breakdown was 73 fourth grade boys; 86 fifth grade boys; 20 fourth grade girls; 28 fifth grade girls. Every plan written resulted in a student commitment to make better choices and learn from their mistakes.
