Your answers to the questions below will NOT affect your dependents coverage. The school district is collecting this information as part of its implementation of the extended dependency coverage provisions of the new federal health care law, The Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (PPAC).

Under the PPAC, a young adult between the ages of 19 and 26 may continue with or re-enroll on a parent's health insurance plan regardless of whether he or she is living in Vermont or with the parent/subscriber, and regardless of marital status or job status, income, financial dependence on the subscriber or student status. There is only one exception to this rule. Young adults between the ages of 19 and 26 may be excluded from staying on or re-enrolling on a parent's health plan if they are eligible for health insurance coverage through their employer's plan. This exception only exists until July 1, 2014.
