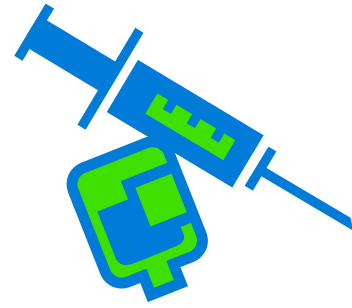

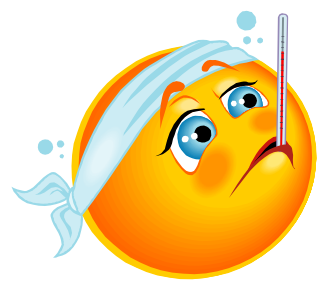


PARENT CONFERENCE LETTERS
